The latest Long Flat initiative should prove popular with bargain-conscious wine lovers. Cheviot Bridge has created the new Long Flat Destinations range, made up of wines that showcase the grape varieties for which six regions are famous - Clare Valley 2006 riesling, Yarra Valley 2006 chardonnay and 2006 pinot noir, Adelaide Hills 2006 sauvignon blanc, Barossa Valley 2005 shiraz and Coonawarra 2004 cabernet sauvignon.

All sell for \$14.95 a bottle and I think the Long Flat 2004 Destinations Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon is particularly good drinking for the money. It has raspberry and cloves scent and shows sweet blackberry flavour on the front of the palate. Elements of herbs, mint and savoury oak chime in on the middle palate and dusty tannins come through at the finish. It will go well with spaghetti carbonara, doner kebabs or barbecued pork chops.
