## OLD VINE CHARDONNAY 2007

### HISTORY

The Terrace Vale vineyard was planted in 1971 on some of the best soils of the Lower Hunter Valley. Alain Le Prince has been the only winemaker at Terrace Vale, where for over thirty years, he has overseen each vintage and produced wines that have won over 400 medals and trophies.

### VITICULTURE

The Terrace Vale Chardonnay vineyards are amongst the oldest in Australia, first planted over thirty years ago. The planting of Chardonnay proved to be a wise decision, with the Terrace Vale Chardonnay winning “Best Chardonnay” at the Hunter Valley Boutique Wine Show for three consecutive years. The medal tally for this wine has grown over time and currently stands at 135 medals.

### WINEMAKING

The grapes from the old vineyard were picked and gently pressed prior to fermentation. Maturation was carried out in small French oak barrels.

### 2007 VINTAGE

This wine shows subtle aromas of honeysuckle, followed by lovely peach flavours on a medium length palate. It has a lingering finish with hints of Mango.
