HISTORY

The Terrace Vale vineyards were planted in 1971 on some of the best soils in the lower Hunter Valley. There has only been one winemaker at Terrace Vale, the legendary but humble Alain Leprince. For over thirty years Alain has overseen each vintage and produced wines that have won over 435 medals and 20 trophies.

VITICULTURE

Analysis of the Terrace Vale vineyards showed a section that was characterised by podsod volcanic clay. Ideal for red varieties, we planted over 10 hectares of Shiraz on this patch when we first laid out the vineyards. This decision has been rewarded many times over with our Terrace Vale Shiraz having showed exceptionally well over the years.

2007 VINTAGE

Dry Winter followed by some rain in February, producing vibrant reds. Subtle liquorice blackcurrent bouquet, spicy full flavoured with lingering dark chocolate.
