Australia shiraz is still one of the hottest wine categories among consumers.

There's something extra going on in this shiraz, even hints of complexity. Quite elegant aromas of minty black cherry, cedar and chocolate awaken the senses to something special. On the palate, lots of spicy black cherry and chocolate unfold with a nice cedary core from oak aging. The long finish shows vanilla, blueberry and black pepper notes amid the minty black cherry profile.
