This sort of thing must put the frighteners into the stalwarts of the Adelaide Hills: their signature wine, widely selling at just \$11 or \$12 a bottle! It's enough to make you hit the bottle.

The aromas are correct and inviting - herbal, slightly vegetal and brackeny as well as gooseberry scented. The palate emphasises the greener spectrum of sauvignon blanc flavour but has good intensity and vitality: it doesn't fall apart on the finish like some do. It's fruity but not sugared up, either. A great bargain. Serve with snapper poached with fennel root.
