VINEYARD

The fruit for this wine came from the Tullymore vineyard to the east of the town of Clare itself. The vines were planted on red clay loam over limestone soils at 450 metres above sea level. The grapes were picked in March.

WINEMAKING

The grapes were cold soaked for 5 days and then warmed up and fermented in open-top fermenters with daily pump-overs and regular drain and returns to maximise the extraction of colour, flavour and tannins from the skins. The grapes were then pressed off skins and the wine transferred to new and second use French and American oak barrels for barrel maturation.

WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

Vibrant deep purples and reds in the glass, this wine shows the classic Clare Cabernet characters of blackcurrant. Plum cassis and crushed violets on the nose with enticing cedary notes. The palate features black ripe berries, mulberries and plum fruit with well-integrated oak framed by elegant tannins. The length and depth of this wine is intense and seductive.
