Viticulture

This wine comes from a mixture of vineyards across the South Eastern region of Australia. The 2007 summer ripening period was mild and fruit ripened steadily. At Harvest the vineyards delivered balanced acid and sugar ripeness resulting in a wine with optimum flavour, distinct varietal characters and good natural acidity.

Winemaker's Comments

The grapes were fermented on skins between 5-7 days in a mix of vessel types. Cabernet and shiraz were kept as separate batches and until final blending prior to bottling. A blend of 60% Cabernet Sauvignon and 40% shiraz. This deep vibrant red shows dusty cassis, with blackberry, spice and mocha aromas which lead to a palate of ripe blackberry and spice. The cabernet adds structure and depth, whilst rich plum fruit from the shiraz fills and softens the palate.
