Viticulture

This wine comes from a mixture of vineyards across the South Eastern region of Australia. The 2008 summer ripening period was hot and dry resulting in small berries with concentrated flavour. At harvest the vineyards delivered balanced acid and sugar ripeness resulting in a wine with optimum flavour, distinct varietal characters and good natural acidity.

Winemaker's Comments

The 2008 Shiraz is vibrant red with an aroma of lifted cherry and plum fruits with a touch of white pepper and spice undertones. Juicy plum fruit fills the front and mid palate, followed by a minty finish with soft tannis and balanced acidity. A vibrant, soft and fruit driven wine.
