Margaret River Cabernet Merlot 2008

Aromas of dark chocolate and coffee... tobacco-leaf and blackcurrant... cigar box and spice... spicy plum and blueberry.

The palate follows with fleshy, ripe, red and blackberry flavours, a gorgeous creamy texture, and some toasty spicy oak.

There's nothing better than rich, dark chocolate and dense blackcurrant with a touch of mint rounded out by some stylish French oak. Add a touch of red-berried Merlot to flesh it out and cabernet merlot by brad is hard to beat.

With fruit sourced from southern Margaret River vineyards we reckon this is pretty smart stuff. Cab Merlot is classy says brad.
